

GENERAL ORDINANCE # 2

WABASH COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, acting in conjunction with the Plan Commission of Wabash County, Indiana have made application to the Farmers Home Administration, a sub-agency of the United States Department of Agriculture, for a grant of funds to prepare a comprehensive water and sewage plan study for Wabash County, Indiana, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana that the Wabash County Plan Commission shall, in all respects, in dealing with the Federal Government on the above mentioned project comply with all the terms contained in an equal opportunity agreement and a non-discrimination agreement numbered FHA Form 400-1 and 400-4 respectively, copies of which are attached hereto and made a part hereof.


