

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 1,
1963

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PLAN
COMMISSION FOR WABASH COUNTY,
INDIANA.

WHEREAS: The Legislature of the State of Indiana has heretofore passed an enabling statute providing that the Board of County Commissioners of each County in the State of Indiana may create a Plan Commission for their respective counties, and,

WHEREAS: The improvement of present health, safety, convenience and welfare of the citizens of this county is desirable, and,

WHEREAS: The planning for the future development of our communities to the end ~~that~~ highway systems should be carefully planned, that new community centers grow only with adequate highway, utility, health, and educational and recreational facilities, is desirable, and,

WHEREAS: The needs for agriculture, industry and business should be recognized in future growth; and,

WHEREAS: The residential areas of this county should provide healthy surroundings for family life;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WABASH COUNTY, INDIANA, that:

SECTION 1. A Planning Commission pursuant to the Acts of 1947, Chapter 174, is hereby established.

SECTION 2. Said Plan Commission shall be denominated the Wabash County Planning Commission.

SECTION 3. The Wabash County Planning Commission shall operate under the Acts of 1947, Chapter 174, and acts amendatory thereto, and shall have all the powers, obligations and duties prescribed by the Legislature of Indiana or by the Board of County Commissioners from time to time hereafter.
