ORDINANCE NO. 2020-85- 5

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS
(Servia stop signs and speed limit)**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Wabash County to amend General Ordinance No. 94-9, to provide for motor vehicles traveling on Mulberry Street to stop at its intersections with Smith Street, Tanner Street, and Sims Street.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that the speed limit on 2nd Street, starting at its intersection with Smith Street and ending at its intersection with County Road 900 North, should be twenty (20) miles per hour.


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that the speed limit on Sugar Street, starting at its intersection with South Street and ending at its intersection with County Road 900 North, should be twenty (20) miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Motor vehicles traveling on Mulberry Street shall stop at its intersections with Smith Street, Tanner Street, and Sims Street.
2. Motor vehicles traveling on Smith Street shall stop at its intersection with 2nd Street.
3. Motor vehicles traveling on Tanner Street shall stop at its intersection with 2nd Street.
4. Motor vehicles traveling on Sims Street shall stop at its intersection with 2nd Street.
5. Motor vehicles traveling on South Street shall stop at its intersection with County Road 300 East, also known as Main Street.
6. Motor vehicles traveling on Tanner Street shall stop at its intersection with Sugar Street.
7. Motor vehicles traveling on Sims Street shall stop at its intersection with Sugar Street.
8. The speed limit on 2nd Street, starting at its intersection with Smith Street and ending at its intersection with County Road 900 North, shall be twenty (20) miles per hour. Any person violating this section of the Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class C infraction.
9. The speed limit on Sugar Street, starting at its intersection with South Street and ending at its intersection with County Road 900 North, shall be twenty (20) miles per hour. Any person violating this section of the Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class C infraction.
10. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signs in accordance with this Ordinance.
