ORDINANCE NO. 2021-85-12

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR COMMERCIAL SOLAR ENERGY SYTEMS

The Board of Commissioners has been advised that the Wabash County Plan Commission requires additional time to draft a proposed ordinance addressing regulations for the installation of solar energy systems, to be presented to the Board of Commissioners for its consideration.


The Board of Commissioners believes it to be in the best interests of the citizens of Wabash County if it would extend to December 31, 2021, the moratorium on improvement location permits for commercial solar energy systems presently scheduled to expire September 30, 2021.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED:

1. No improvement location permits shall be issued allowing construction of commercial solar energy systems until the Board of Commissioners adopts an ordinance regulating the installation of commercial solar energy systems.
2. This Ordinance shall expire upon adoption of an ordinance regulating the installation of commercial solar energy systems, or December 31, 2021, whichever first occurs.
3. This Ordinance shall be in effect upon is adoption.


