IT IS NOW RESOLVED:


The following paragraph of Section 305 of the Wabash County, Indiana, Employee Handbook:


“Wabash County Government will grant paid holiday time off to all eligible employees who have completed 180 calendar days of service in an eligible employment classification. Holiday pay will be calculated based on the employee’s straight-time pay rate (as of the date of the holiday) times the number of hours the employee would otherwise have worked on that day. Eligible employee classification(s): Regular full-time employees.”


shall be amended to read as follows:

“Wabash County Government will grant paid holiday time off to all eligible employees who have completed 30 calendar days of service in an eligible employment classification. Holiday pay will be calculated based on the employee’s straight-time pay rate (as of the date of the holiday) times the number of hours the employee would otherwise have worked on that day. Eligible employee classification(s): Regular full-time employees and introductory employees who have completed at least 30 calendar days of service.”
