

RESOLUTION # 2-93

WHEREAS, there is a scheduled real estate reassessment to be commenced in Wabash County in 1993 and completed by 1995; and

WHEREAS, it is the considered intention of Wabash County to employ the services of a reassessment firm to complete the process; and


WHEREAS, it is understood by the Commissioners of Wabash County and the County Assessor that a 10% retainage fee may be incorporated in the contract for reassessment in lieu of requiring a performance bond.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County of Wabash, State of Indiana, by its County Commissioners, Dean Eppley, Darle Dawes and Brian K. Haupert, that in respect to the 1993 reassessment it has been determined that it would be in the best interest of the County of Wabash to waive the need of a performance bond and instead to enter into a contract incorporating a 10% retainage fee.
