

RESOLUTION FOR ACCEPTANCE OF GRATIS TRANSFER

Comes now the Commissioners for the County of Wabash, State of Indiana, and after being first duly sworn upon oath, do hereby say and resolve as follows:

Whereas, it is the understanding of the Commissioners that the Indiana Department of Transportation is abandoning the sub-district garage at Wabash, Indiana; and


Whereas, the land and buildings of said sub-district garage are very conveniently located to the County Highway garage and grounds serving Wabash County; and

Whereas, it is understood that a gratis transfer of said property could occur inuring to the benefit and use by Wabash County of said abandoned sub-district garage.


IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by the undersigned County Commissioners for the County of Wabash, State of Indiana, that they are desirous of and willing to accept the gratis transfer of the Indiana Department of Transportation sub-district garage to include buildings and real estate, at Wabash, Indiana, with the understanding that a reversion clause would be placed in the deed causing said property to revert to the State of Indiana if the county ceases to use said property for a designated public purpose.

Affirmed and signed this 26 day of February, 1990.


