

RESOLUTION CONCERNING ALLOCATION OF
REVENUE SHARING FUNDS

WHEREAS, in 1972, the United States Federal Government initiated a program of returning to local governmental units a portion of its tax revenue, which program will likely continue for an indefinite period; and,

WHEREAS, there exist within Wabash County, Indiana many not-for-profit organizations which provide valuable and necessary human services; and,

WHEREAS, many of these valuable non-profit organizations have need of financial assistance in order to ensure their continuation; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County desires to receive more input from the citizens of Wabash County concerning the use to be made of federal revenue sharing funds; and,

WHEREAS, the expressed intention of the United States Congress in distributing revenue sharing funds to local governmental units provides for a portion of the funds to be expended for human service programs, which programs are generally not included within budgets supported by local tax revenues.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that beginning with the 1979 fiscal year, ten percent (10%) or Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00), whichever is greater, of the federal revenue sharing funds allocated to Wabash County, Indiana, should be set aside for use by non-profit organizations which fulfill human service needs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that application for any such funds should be by written request directed to the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana. Any request approved by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana shall then be presented to the Wabash County Council for its approval or rejection. All approved requests shall then be advertised in the same manner as are other requests for additional appropriations of funds from the county general fund. All unused portions of funds allocated hereunder shall revert to the revenue sharing trust account at the conclusion of each fiscal year.
