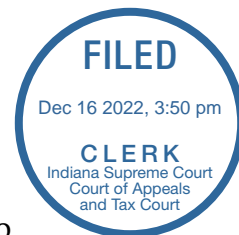

Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

Judge Jill D. Wesch, of the Vermillion Circuit Court, has notified this Court that she is resigning from the bench effective December 16, 2022. Senior Judge Robert M. Hall has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore in the Vermillion Circuit Court beginning on December 17, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that, pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Robert M. Hall is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in Vermillion Circuit Court, effective December 17, 2022, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Hall to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Vermillion Circuit Court until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Hall shall be entitled to compensation for his service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
