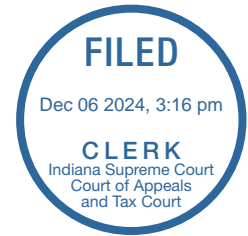

Order

On September 11, 2024, this Court granted the State’s request to set an execution date for Joseph Corcoran, with the execution scheduled for December 18, 2024. On December 5, 2024, a majority of the Court denied motions to stay the execution in case number 24S-SD-222.

Also on December 5, Corcoran’s counsel appealed two trial court orders dated December 2, 2024 denying motions for relief under Trial Rule 60(B). On December 6, Corcoran’s counsel filed a motion to stay the December 18 execution while this appeal is being litigated.

Being duly advised, the Court ORDERS the State to file a response to the “Motion for Stay of Execution” no later than **12:00 p.m. on Monday, December 9, 2024**. No extensions of time shall be granted absent extraordinary circumstances, and no reply brief will be permitted.
