

# LSA Document #24-260 DFBS Civil Penalties

## **PUBLIC HEARING RECORD**

#### Overview

On September 13, 2024, at 9:00 a.m., Indianapolis (Eastern) time, the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission (Commission) held a public hearing on their proposed rule (LSA Document #24-260) adding a rule establishing the framework the Indiana Department of Homeland Security must follow when imposing civil penalties under Ind. Code § 22-12-7-7.
