## FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL

A Notice of Proposed Dismissal was entered in this matter on August 16, 2024. The findings in that Notice are incorporated by reference. The Notice was served on Petitioner on August 16, 2024 by email and gave Petitioner seven (7) days from the date of the Notice of Proposed Dismissal to file a motion requesting a final order of dismissal not be imposed and stating the grounds relied upon for the request. More than seven days have passed since the Notice of Proposed Dismissal was issued, and no such motion has been filed with the Office of Administrative Law Proceedings. Pursuant to Ind. Code 4-21.5-3-24(c), the ALJ issues this Final Order to dismiss the case, with prejudice.

The ALJ assigned to this mater by the Director of the Office of Administrative Law Proceedings (OALP), see Ind. Code § 4-15-10.5-13, has jurisdiction over this case pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-15-10.5-12, which gives OALP jurisdiction over agency administrative actions subject to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act at Indiana Code Art. 4-21.5 (AOPA) or "any other statute that requires or allows the office to take action." The OALP has jurisdiction over this case because this case is governed by AOPA. See 410 IAC 16.2-3.1-12.
