

ORDINANCE NO. 4-2017

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 29-2016 ADOPTING
INSTALLATION OF CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS IN NEW CONSTRUCTION**

WHEREAS, the Common Council voted unanimously to adopt Ordinance No. 29-2016 on December 5, 2016; and,

WHEREAS, the Indiana Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission has recommended to the Common Council of the City of LaPorte that the Ordinance 29-2016 be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of La Porte as follows:

SECTION I. That Section 2, Carbon Monoxide Detector Requirement, is hereby amended to remove the following language:

For every building for which a building permit is issued for new construction on or after December 31, 2016 and having a fireplace, attached garage, or fossil fuel burning building, shall have one (1) operational Carbon Monoxide Detector.


SECTION II. That Section 2, Carbon Monoxide Detector Requirement, is hereby amended to add the following language:

For all buildings of a Class 2 structure designed for residential use for which a building permit is issued for new construction on or after December 31, 2016 and having a fireplace, attached garage, or fossil fuel burning appliance, shall have at least one (1) operational Carbon Monoxide Detector per unit. Installation of the Carbon Monoxide Detector shall be in accordance with the Manufacturers specifications and recommendations.


SECTION III. In all other regards, Ordinance 29-2016 shall be unchanged.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor and publication as required by law.




