

## REPORTING OF CRIMINAL CONVICTION FORM

655 IAC 2-2-5 and 655 IAC 2-2-6

The Board of Firefighting Personnel Standards and Education may act against an individual's certification under certain circumstances. These include instances where the individual has failed to uphold privacy, dignity or safety of another individual; committed a breach of examination security or integrity; been convicted of a crime; or violated Board rules.

The Board may take any action in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3, IC 4-21.5-4 and IC 22-12-7, including, but not limited to, suspension or revocation of certifications. The Fire and Public Safety Academy or Board may initiate a review even in the absence of external written requests or complaints.

An individual certified by the Board must provide written notice to the department within 90 days of any misdemeanor or felony criminal conviction, except traffic-related misdemeanors other than operating a motor vehicle under the influence of a drug or alcohol.
