

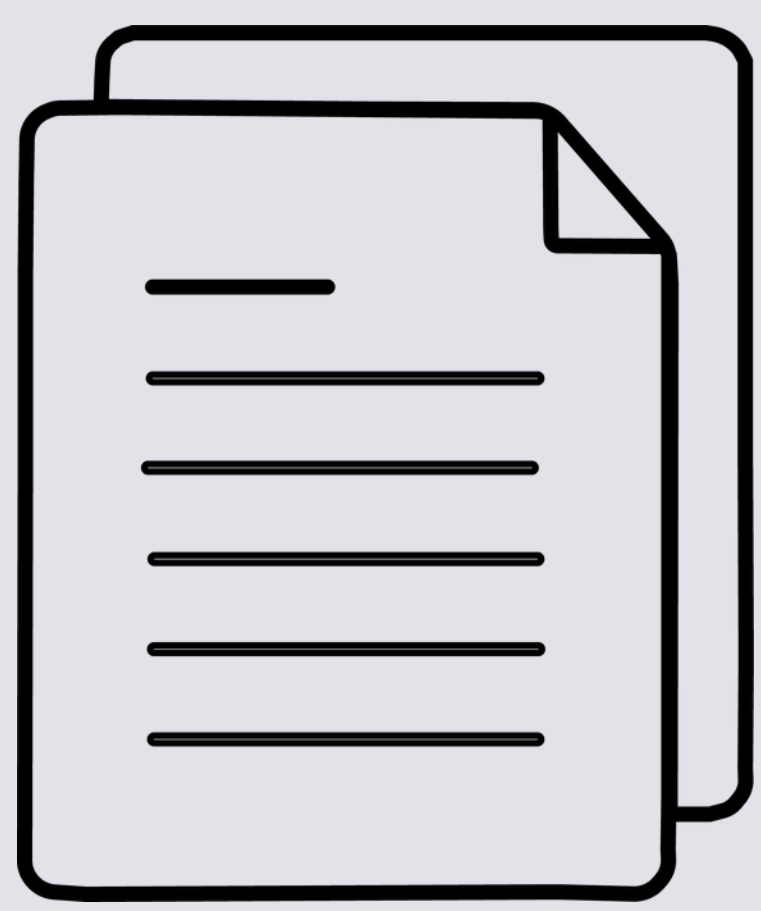

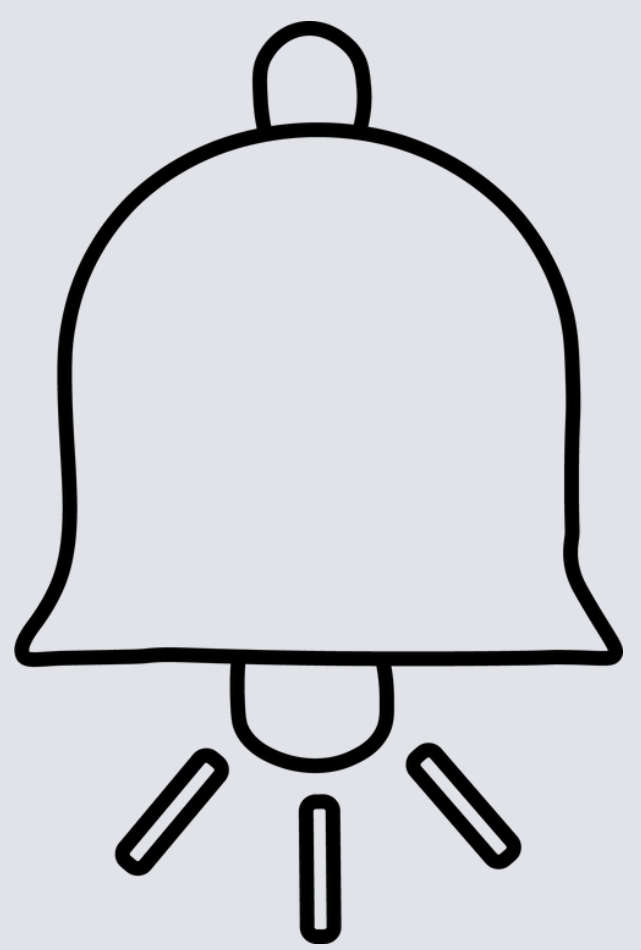

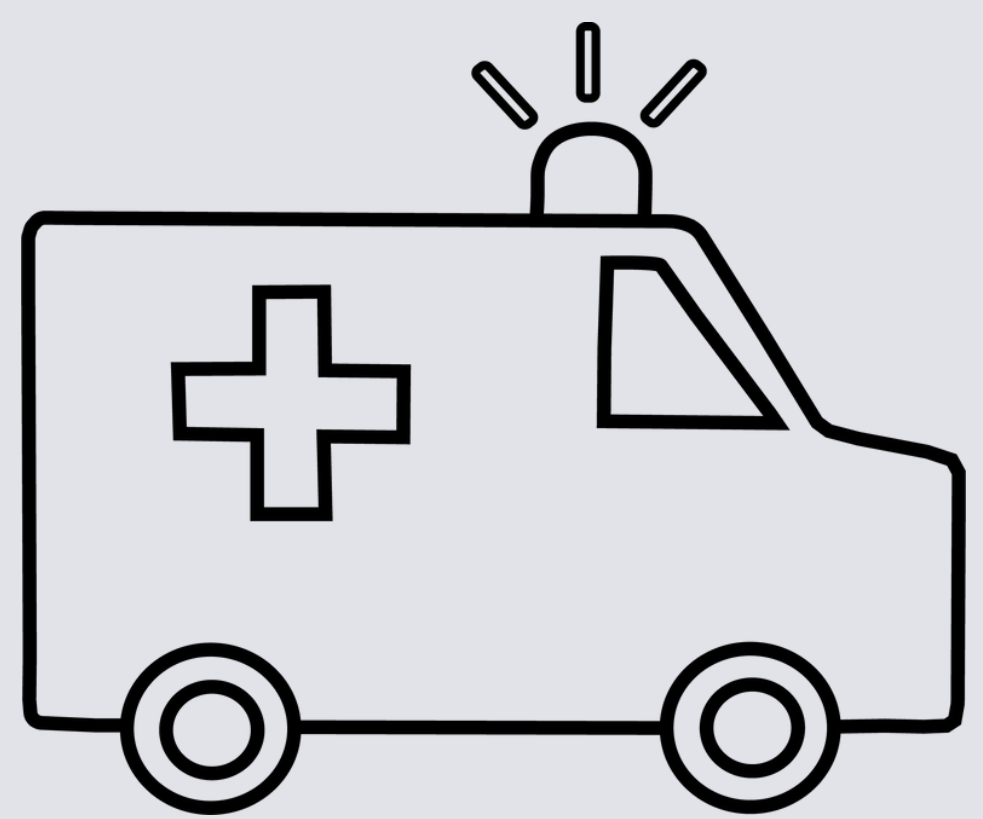
Maintained **37** emergency plans and analyzed **63** threat and hazard assessments



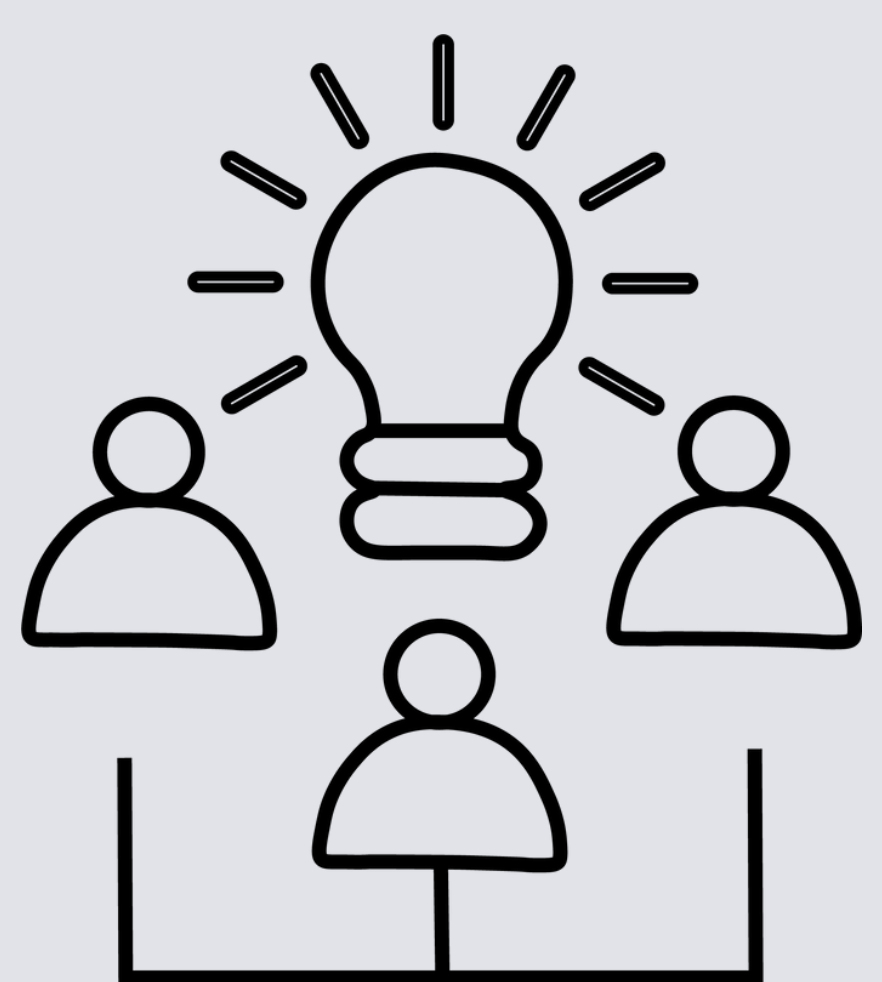
Hosted **30** exercises for **1,299** participants

Graduated **18** students from the FEMA Basic Academy

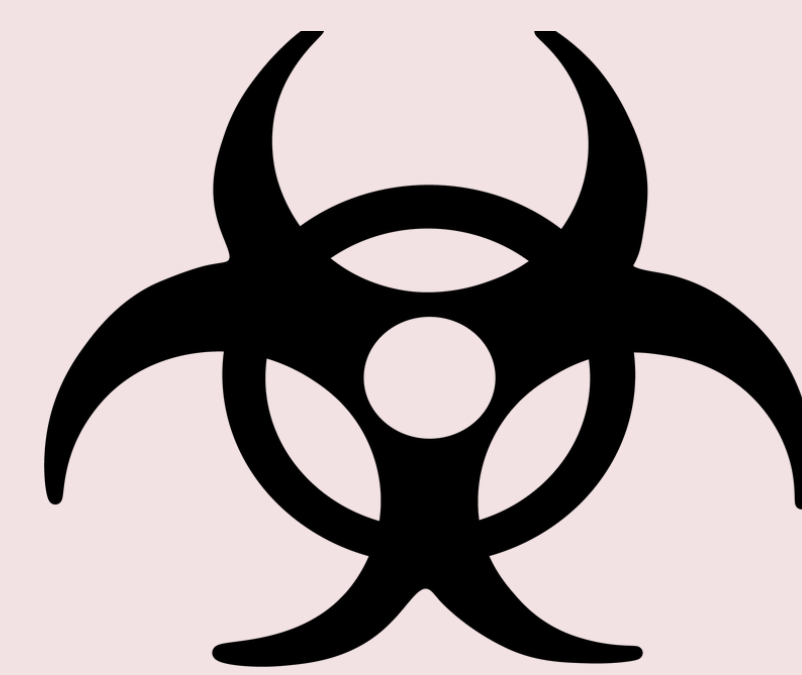

Investigated **877** fire and explosion incidents



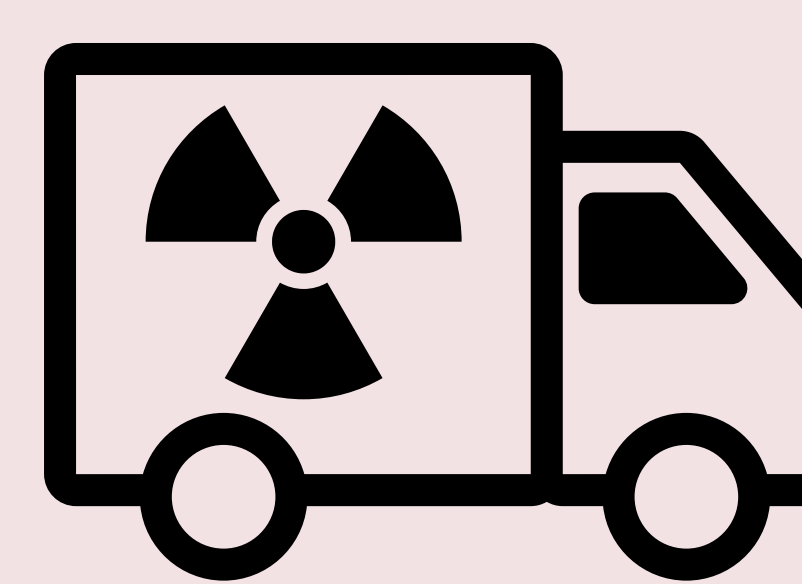

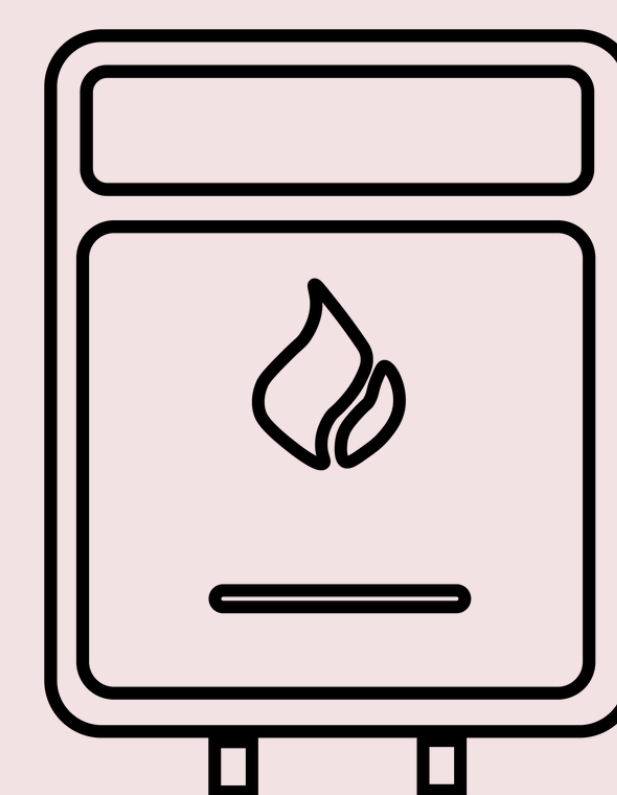

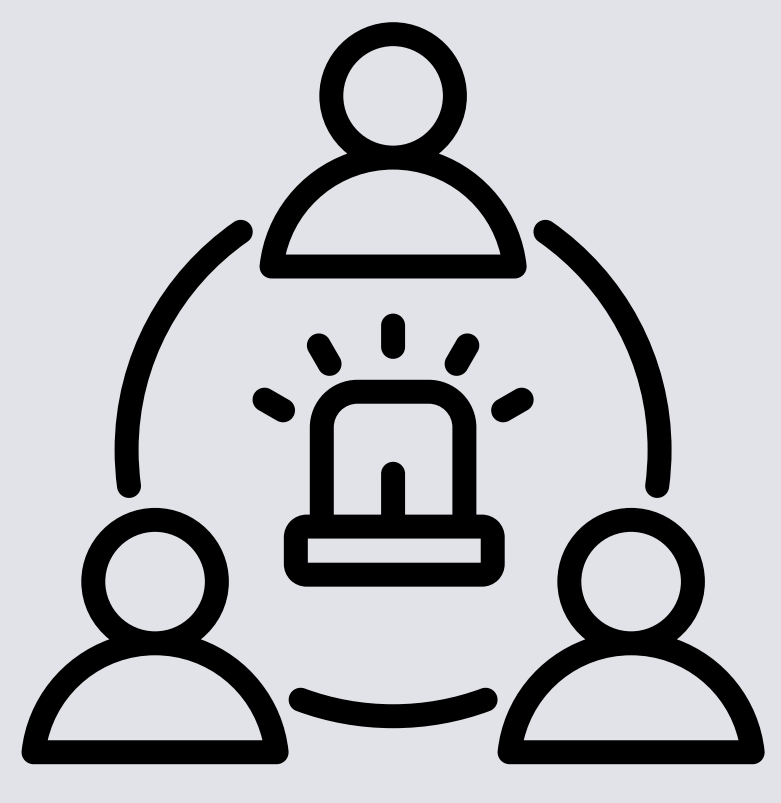
Issued **226** Low Level Waste Permits and **1** High Level Waste Permit



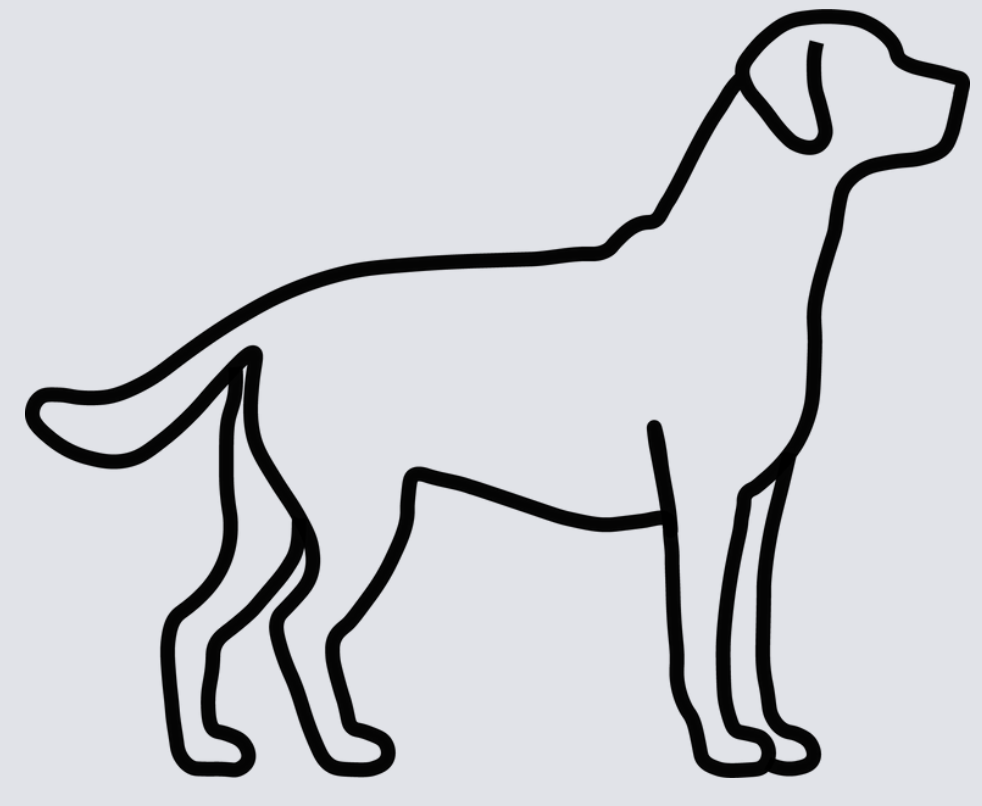
Inspected **12,138** boiler/pressure vessels



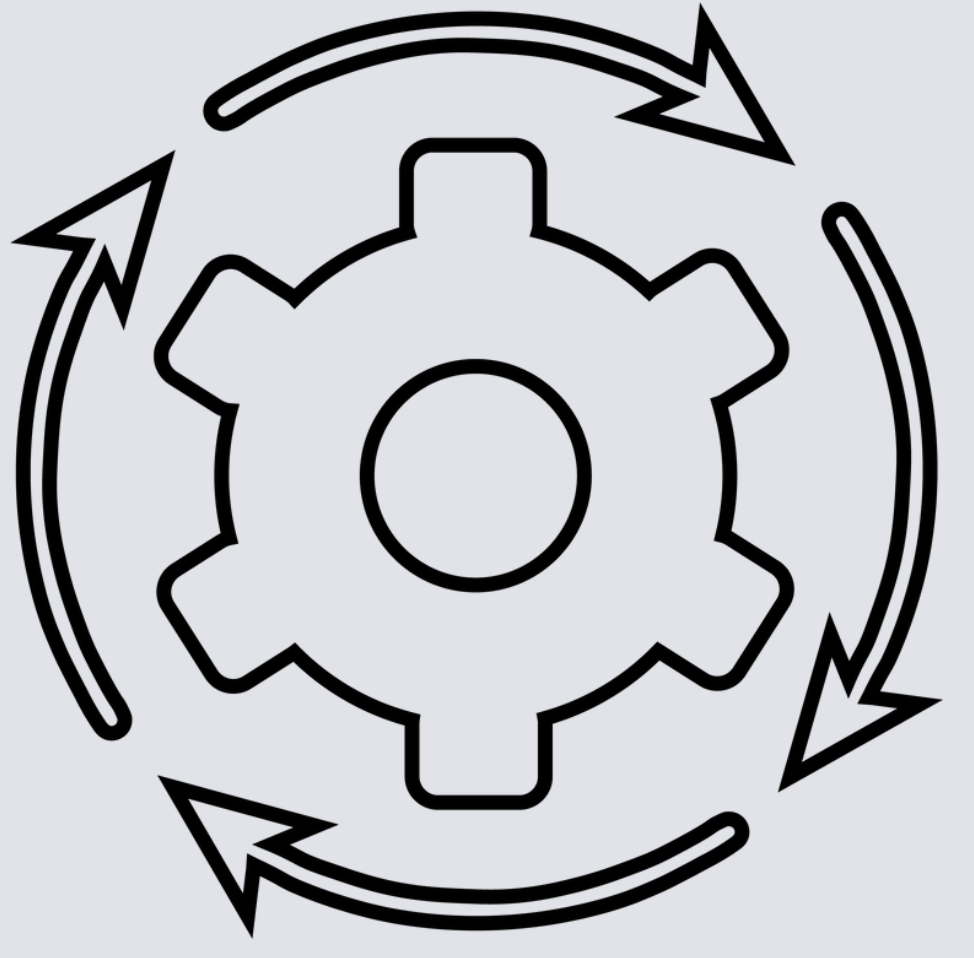
Issued **810** firework permits/licenses



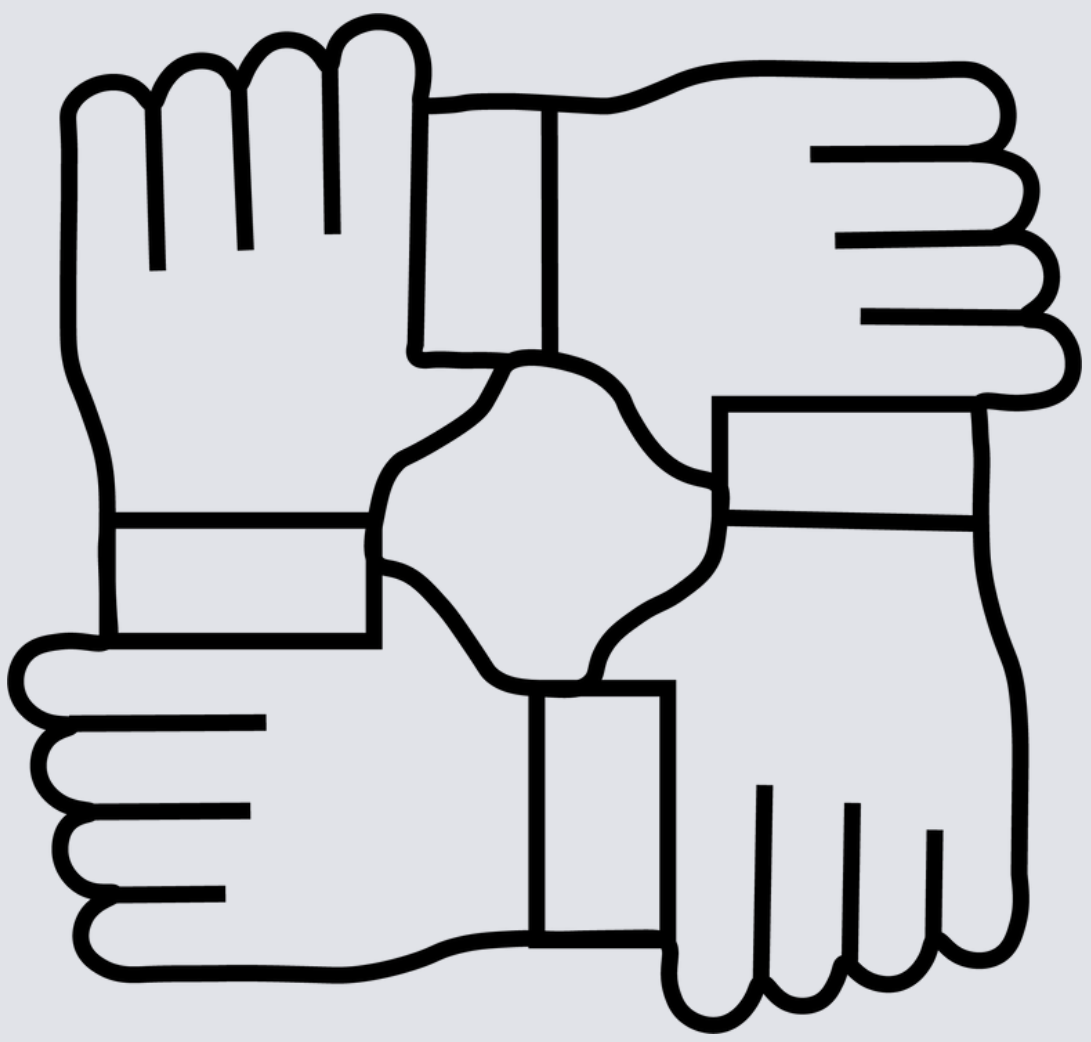
Help **11** individuals obtain their Professional Emergency Manager (PEM) certification.



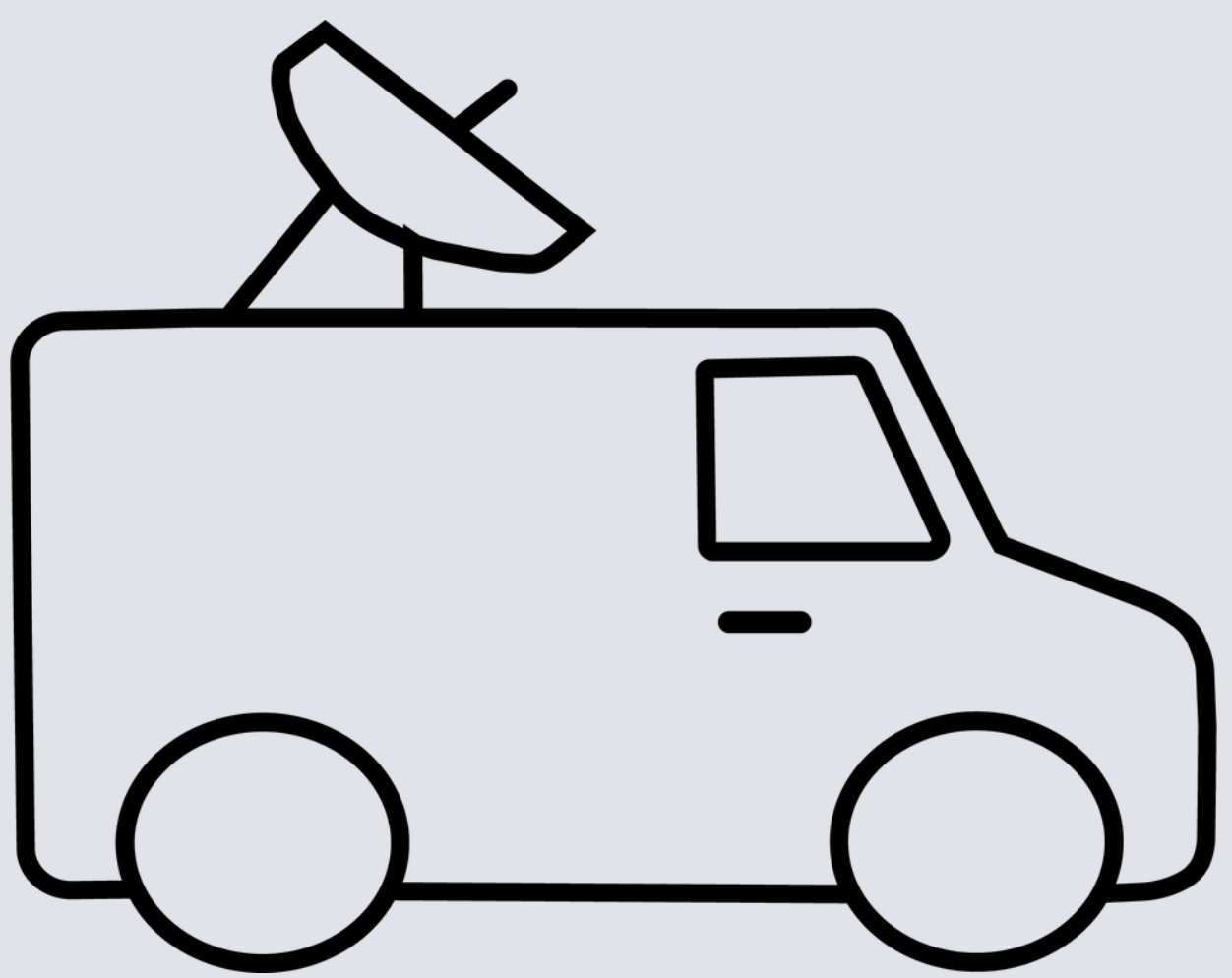
Deployed the K-9 unit **33** times



Activated the State Emergency Operations Center **4** times to support local disasters.

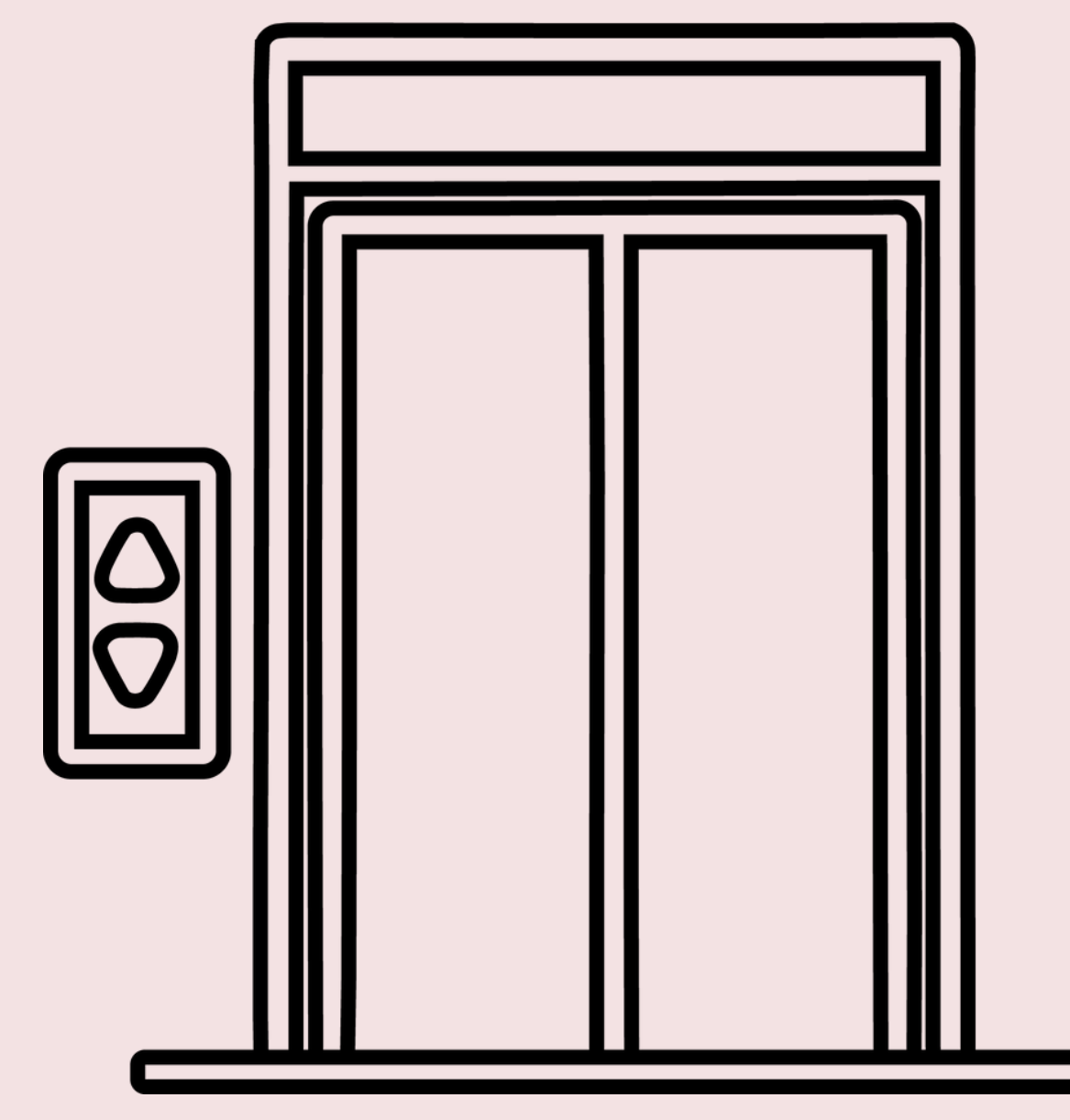


Supported **7** special events with command vehicles and other IDHS resources.

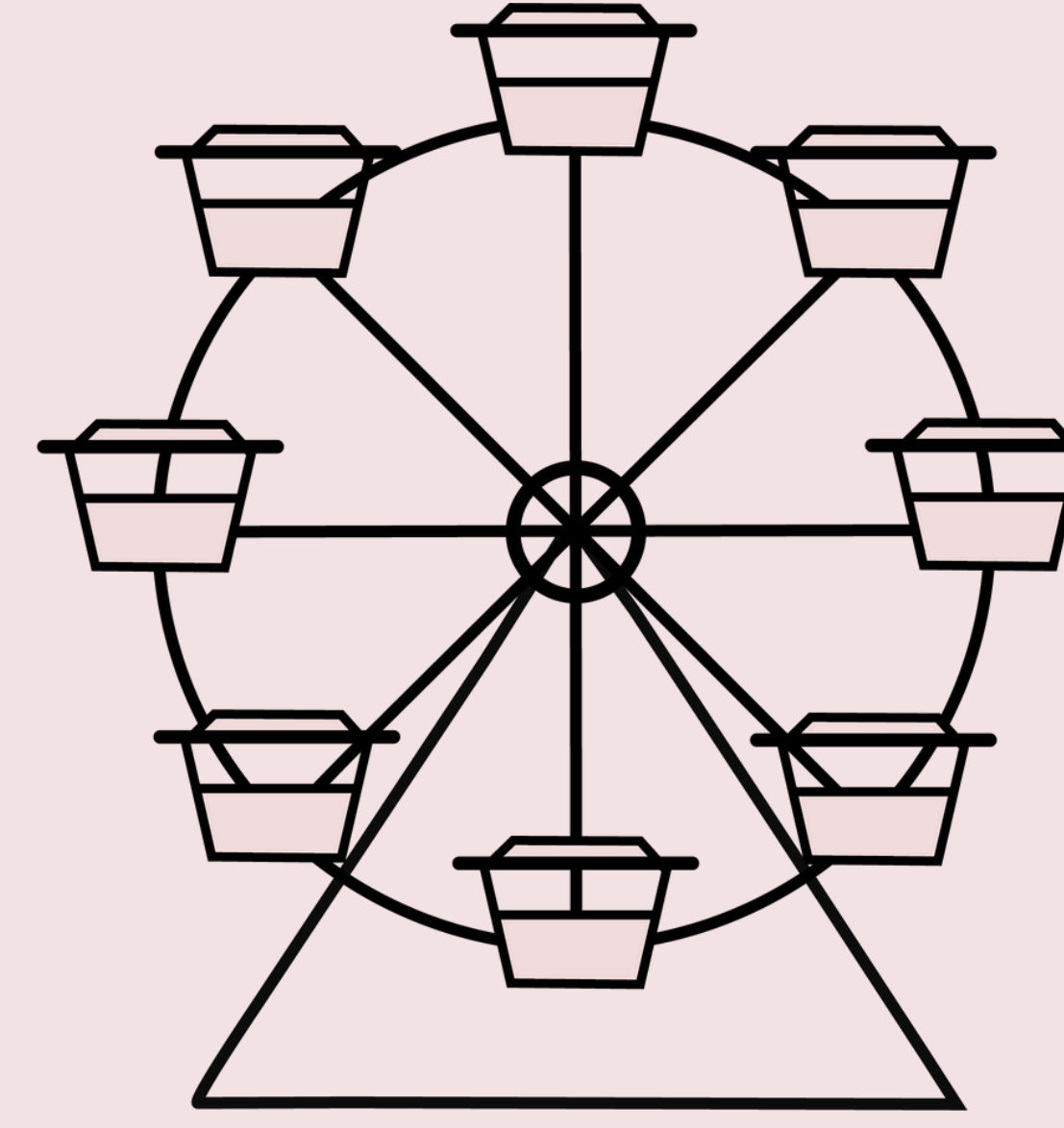


Deployed the Mobile Command Center **3** times and supported **5** counties for real-world incidents.

*These figures represent only arrests and convictions that occurred during the set time frame. Cases that are resolved after the fiscal year will be included in next year's totals.



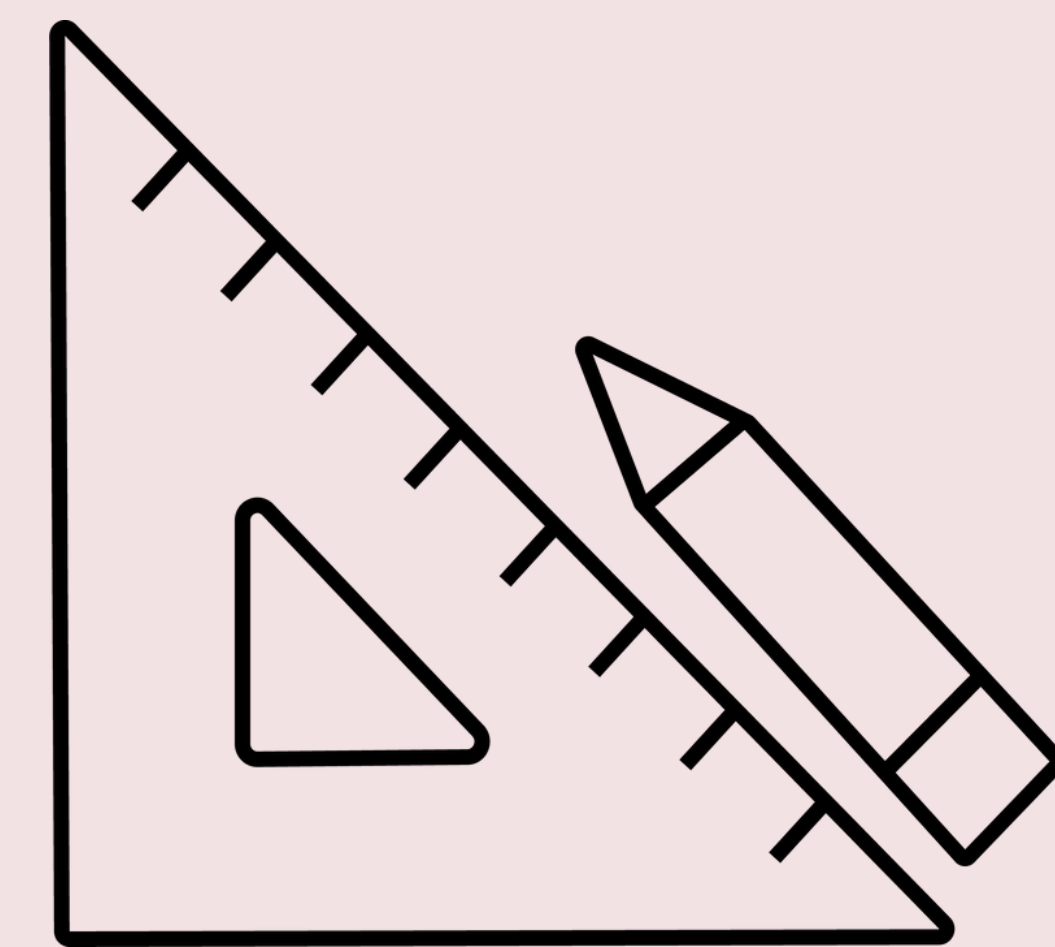
