

USING THE WEBEOC MOBILE APP

WEBEOC MOBILE APP

The WebEOC mobile app provides a means to access and enter information on the go. Refer to the installation guide for details on how to install and log into the WebEOC mobile app.

INTERFACE

Once you have successfully logged in, you will see a screen like the image below. This document will briefly describe each function

POSITION

If you have been assigned to more than one position, you may change position using this dropdown.

INCIDENT

You may select **Daily Operations** or a different incident by using this dropdown.

NOTIFICATION PREFERENCES

If you have been assigned to more than one position, you may change the positions for which you receive notifications.

LAUNCH WEBEOC

This link opens WebEOC in the default browser of your mobile device. As such, the boards displayed may lack some of the advantages of a board specifically designed with mobile capabilities.

ACCOUNT

The image displayed above shows the account screen.

NOTIFICATIONS

Boards may be set up to provide notifications of new and/or changed data. Any notifications for your currently selected position and incident will be displayed by tapping this icon.

BOARDS

The boards section displays the names of all boards which have been specifically designed with the advantages of a mobile, responsive interface in mind.

The following is an example of the boards that may be available in this section:

- Indiana Events/Incidents
- Checklists
- Facility Site Status
- Incident Action Plan (Published)
- Important Dates Calendar
- Logistics—Distribution Sites
- Logistics—Resource Catalog
- Road/Bridge Closures
- Social Media Exercise Simulator

This is not an exhaustive list of the boards available for mobile devices. Available boards will change depending on the boards assigned to the selected position.

FORMS

Indiana does not currently utilize WebEOC mobile forms. If this changes in the future, this document will be updated to reflect any new functionality implemented.

MORE

This screen offers the following:

- Launch WebEOC
 - Launch WebEOC has the same functionality as Launch WebEOC described previously.
- Manage Accounts
 - Manage Accounts allows the setup of an account on another WebEOC system.
- Settings
 - Settings allows you to change the status of push notifications, default browser and (for iOS devices) whether FaceID is allowed.
- About
 - About provides additional information about the mobile app.
