Rule 5. Certification reinstatement after expiration

655 IAC 4-5-2 Reinstatement Procedure

Sec. 2. (a) Reinstatement of an expired certification may be requested by submitting:

a certification reinstatement request containing all information required by the department; (2) documentation that proves the individual completed all required continuing education hours prior to the expiration of the certification; and (3) a fifty dollar (\$50) nonrefundable reinstatement fee. (b) A certification reinstatement request must be submitted in compliance with a submission procedure established and administered by the department. (c) The department shall approve certification reinstatement requests that meet the requirements set forth in this rule.

655 IAC 4-5-3 Reinstatement deadline

Sec. 3. (a) The submission described in this rule must be completed within one hundred twenty (120) days of the date that the certification expired. (b) Failure to comply with the deadline described in subsection (a) shall prohibit the reinstatement of a certification. (c) An individual who is prohibited from reinstatement of an expired certification shall be required to obtain a new certification in accordance with the education board rules.

655 IAC 4-5-4 Effective date of reinstatement

Sec. 4. (a) A certification shall be reinstated effective on the date that the reinstatement is approved. (b) A reinstated certification must be renewed prior to the expiration of the period described in Rule 4 of this article.
