

These officers play a critical role in ensuring safety during hazardous materials incidents.



Option 2: <u>THE METER GUYS</u>— AIR MONITORING FOR FIRST RESPONDERS

The Meter Guys is an innovative simultaneous hands-on lecture meter training program focused on First Responders, Hazmat Personnel, and Industrial workers. This class provides students with the skills and competencies on how to properly use a 4-Gas Meter, understand the readings they are seeing, and interpret the implications of such during an emergency response or in their daily routine. This class focuses on the hazardous materials most frequently encountered in transportation and has application to both the emergency response and industrial communities. The importance of meters cannot be understated, and this class will enlighten students to understand the dangers that are lurking around them.
