

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-19

An Ordinance establishing a Local Service Fee

WHEREAS, I.C. 6-1.1-3-7.3 authorizes the County Council to impose, by ordinance, a local service fee on each person that files an annual certification with the county assessor under I.C. 6-1.1-3-7.2 stating that the person's business personal property in the county is exempt from taxation under that section for an assessment date after December 31, 2015.

WHEREAS, I.C. 6-1.1-3-7.3 the County Council shall specify the amount of the local service fee which may not exceed more than \$50.

WHEREAS, I. C. 6-1.1-3-7.3 the local service fee imposed for an assessment date is due and payable at the same time that property taxes for that assessment date are due and payable. Randolph County may collect a delinquent local service fee in the same manner as delinquent property taxes are collected.

WHEREAS, Revenue from the local service fee shall be allocated in the same manner and proportion and at the same time as property taxes are allocated to each taxing unit in Randolph County and may be used by Randolph County for any lawful purpose.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the County Council of Randolph County, Indiana, that:







1. Randolph County shall impose a local service fee in the amount of \$50 on each person that files an annual certification with the county assessor under I.C. 6-1.1-3-7.2 stating that the person's business personal property in the county is exempt from taxation under that section for an assessment date after December 31, 2015.

2. The local service fee imposed for an assessment date is due and payable at the same time that property taxes for that assessment date are due and payable. Randolph County may collect a delinquent local service fee in the same manner as delinquent property taxes are collected.

3. Revenue from the local service fee shall be allocated in the same manner and proportion and at the same time as property taxes are allocated to each taxing unit in Randolph County and may be used by Randolph County for any lawful purpose.
