The DNR 30-Day Public Notice is published weekly to serve notice of the latest permit applications received at the DNR, Division of Water. Petition for Public Hearing

A pre-action public hearing on an application may be requested by filing a written petition. For a petition to be considered valid it must:

1. contain the typed or legibly printed name and complete mailing address of each petitioner;
2. be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
3. affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted. To request a pre-action public hearing, send the petition by email to water_inquiry@dnr.in.gov or by mail to:

It will be set back 1,109' from the top of the riverbank and will have a finished elevation of 472'. Filling will occur in a couple low spots, while taking off a couple high spots in the field. Also, light poles and benches will be installed at depths of 2' x 1'. Also, two dilapidated dugouts from an old baseball field will be removed. In addition, some removal of small trees and shrubs will occur.

The new structure will be a single-span prestressed concrete spread box beam bridge with a span length of 35'. The structure will have an out-to-out length of 34.5' and a clear roadway width of 34'. The spill through abutments will have 2:1 sideslopes armored with revetment riprap. The abutments and piers will not be skewed to align with the streamflow. The new approach roads will match the existing approaches.

Project Description: Northern Indiana Public Service Company's (NIPSCO) Michigan City Generating Station Trail Creek Bulkhead Replacement Project proposes to replace the existing Michigan City Generating Station bulkhead with a new sheet pile bulkhead composed of approximately 1,410 linear feet of new steel sheet pile generally offset from the original wall 4-18". The new sheet pile bulkhead will be of similar cantilever retaining wall design and will use modern, structurally efficient sheet piles. The existing bulkhead must remain in place to maintain the existing shoreline. The new sheet pile wall will be designed to minimize the encroachment into Trail Creek while balancing the constructability of driving new sheet piles adjacent to the existing bulkhead.

The existing east and westbound continuous reinforced concrete girder and box beam bridges are 80.5' and 79.4' long, 60.5' and 69.1' wide, both 15' tall and have a 15" and 12" skew (Des: 2100996 and Des. 2100997), respectively. The new east and westbound structures will be approximately 87' long and 68' and 74' wide continuous reinforced concrete slab bridge with the same skew. Riprap and concrete will be placed below the base flood elevation for scour protection, drainage turnouts, and the construction of Pier No. 2 and Pier No. 3. Regrading below the base flood elevation will total 0.09 acres. Permanent impacts total approximately 0.43 acres. No permanent stream impacts will occur. Temporary impacts total approximately 0.55 acres due to the use of cofferdams, check dams, construction access and filter sock. Temporary wetland impacts will total approximately 0.15 acres. Approximately 0.09 acres of tree clearing will be necessary for construction access.
