

Kankakee FWA Deer and Turkey Hunting

Locations:

- o Open for hunting: L-1. L-2, L-3, L-4, S-5, and Tower Field (east of the office).
- o The red areas are **not** open for deer or turkey hunting, these areas are closed all season for waterfowl hunting.

Deer Hunting Rules:

- Deer tree stands and ground blinds may be used and left unattended from noon, Sept. 15 through Jan.
 10.
- o Bonus antlerless deer permits cannot be used.
- o The Special Antlerless Firearms Season is **closed** on Kankakee FWA.
- Tree stands and ground blinds must be legibly marked in English with either the owner's DNR customer identification number or the owner's name, address, and telephone number.
- o Screw-in tree steps, screw-in equipment hangers, and other bark-penetrating devices are prohibited.
- o All ground blinds are required to follow the state's hunter orange requirements.
- Satellite properties have different rules so please find their links on the website: on.IN.gov/kankakeefwa

Turkey Hunting Rules:

- o There is no draw for spring or fall turkey hunting.
- Please fill out a hunting permit and turn it in at the drop boxes. All hunting season dates, and bag limits apply.
- Turkey hunting hours are from ½ hour before sunrise to noon CT.
- Toxic shot is authorized for turkey hunting.
