

Cherry Lake Lodge

at Morgan-Monroe State Forest



DESCRIPTION

Cherry Lake Lodge is a newly renovated historic woodland cabin with all the comforts of home. This unique retreat originated as a duty station for researchers when the state forest was part of the Northeast Forest Experimental Station in the 1930s.

The lodge's large, elevated back porch overlooks acres of natural beauty, making it a great escape from the hustle and bustle of daily life. Watch for deer, wild turkey, and forest wildlife as you relax on the expansive deck and enjoy the comfort of your own woodland retreat.

The Lodge is located by 3 Lakes Trail and Mason Ridge Trail, which respectively offer 10- and 3-mile hiking opportunities. Two-acre Cherry Lake is a short stroll away and makes a great spot for a picnic or throwing out a fishing line from the gentle, manicured shoreline.

Cherry Lake Lodge was completely renovated in 2013. It features two bedrooms, two bathrooms, and a pullout sleeper sofa in the great room. It comfortably sleeps up to six. (queen bed in bedroom #1; queen bed in bedroom #2; sleeper sofa in great room)

The improved floor plan features a new kitchen, adjoining dining area, great room with fireplace, and wide deck across the entire back of the house overlooking the surrounding woods.

Cherry Lake Lodge is only 45 miles from Indianapolis, 30 minutes from Bloomington, and 2 ½ hours from Louisville. It is an ideal location and one-of-a-kind getaway for small retreats and families.

RATES AND RESERVATIONS

- Reservations and prepayment required
- \$175/night plus tax and reservation fee \$1050/week plus tax and reservation fee (7 nights)
- 2 night minimum; 3 night minimum on Holiday Weekends
- 14-day maximum stay
- Check in after 1 p.m. on first day of rental. Check out by 11 a.m. after the last rental night
- Firewood must be bark-free or certified (available for purchase at office)

Cabin Rules: Linens provided. Guests required to do minor housekeeping. **No pets. No smoking.**
