

Early Childhood Transition

Indicator 11 & Indicator 12

Children transitioning from First Steps <u>must</u> meet the <u>third birthday</u> requirement <u>AND</u> the <u>50-instructional day</u> timeline to be considered compliant for indicators 11 and 12.

Indicator 11



Obtain Parental Consent

The evaluation timeline begins after signed parental consent is obtained.



Conduct and Complete

All required components of the Evaluation Process

Timeline Requirement



50 Instructional Days

Allowable Exceptions

- Student enrolls in another LEA after the process has begun.
- Parent revoked consent for evaluation
- Parent repeatedly fails or refuses to produce the student for evaluation.

Indicator 12



First Steps Transition Planning Conference

The LEA will receive contact information from Part C and will reach out to schdule an evaluation.

All required components of the Evaluation Process



Timeline Requirement

Before 3rd Birthday

Allowable Exceptions

- Parent refusal to provide consent caused delayed evaluation or initial services
- Child was referred to Part C less than 90 days prior to child's third birthday
