

## Licensing Verification and Information System (LVIS) Instructions:

Renewing a 10 year Instructional License & Adding the Early Literacy Endorsement

You will need to have approval from the DOE Literacy Center for the 80 hours of Professional Development and Exam before you can add the endorsement. Once approved, the Literacy Center team will send you a letter in an email that you will upload along with your Praxis results. The Jotform form to contact the Literacy Center is below:

## **Step-by-Step Directions:**

- 1. Log into your <u>LVIS</u> account.
- 2. Click the green "Renew, Convert or Professionalize my license" box.
- 3. Select **Teacher**.
- Select Instructional.
- 5. Click I have a 10 year license.
- 6. Click Renew, and Add Early Literacy Endorsement.
- 7. Select the option: Add Instructional Content Area(s).
- 8. Review the required documentation then click **Start Application**.
- 9. **Select your license in the drop-down,** then click the radio button for Yes or No if you are needing to change your degree on your license.
- 10. Answer the legal questions. Upload required documentation, if requested. Click **Next**.
- 11. Upload the required documentation for the **Early Literacy Endorsement and Renewal**. If you have questions about documentation, please see the directions at the top of the section.
- 12. Click Continue.
- 13. On this page, please review your selections and uploaded documentation to assure accuracy. Read and Review Loyalty Affidavit. Click **Submit**.
- 14. Click Make Payment.
- 15. Select the Radio button for Application/Fees to Pay.
- 16. Click **Start Payment Transaction**. You will be redirected to the NIC Payment Portal.
- 17. Enter/Review all required billing information.
- 18. Enter Credit Card Information.
- 19. Click Submit Payment, then you will be redirected back to LVIS. Please capture the receipt shown for your records.

Your application should now have the status of 'DOE Review'. Processing time can vary depending on the time of year. You will receive an email once your application has been approved or if any additional materials are required.
