765. Adult Meals

Finding 10163: Covering adult meal costs

Certain non-foodservice staff receive meals at no cost. A procedure has not been established to ensure non-federal funds are correctly transferred to the non-profit school foodservice account to cover the cost of these meals. These meals must be reconciled monthly.

Corrective Action:

As corrective action, calculate the amount of meals served at no cost for the non-foodservice staff, determine the value of unpaid meals using the current adult meal price, and restore the value to the non-profit food service account using non-federal funds. Supporting documentation for tall hese actions must be submitted to the State Agency.

Technical Assistance:

It is an allowable expense of the non-profit foodservice account, at local discretion, to provide a meal to foodservice staff at no cost. These meals must be tracked in the production record as an adult meal and are not eligible for reimbursement.
