Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 6.3 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 4th in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has increased by 2,114 over the year and is at 3,390,973.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for nine months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 64.0% vs. 61.5% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have decreased by 69,900 over the year.
