- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 2.8 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 7th in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has decreased by 58,061 over the year and is at 3,318,134.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for four months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 62.8% vs. 61.4% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have decreased by 127,000 over the year.
