Functions of Local Board

WIOA requires the local board, in partnership with the chief elected official, to develop and submit a local plan to the Governor that meets the requirements in section 108.

Content Requirements

- Description of strategic planning elements
- Alignment of partners and service delivery
- Local access to services & career pathways
- Employer engagement and demand driven system
- Economic development activities
- Description of One-stop delivery system
- Description and assessment of A and DW E&T activities
- How local board will carry out Rapid Response
- Youth workforce investment activities
- Coordination of secondary & post-secondary ed

Content Requirements—cont'd

- Transportation and supportive services
- Wagner-Peyser
- Adult Education (Title II) and literacy
- Entity disbursing grant funds
- Competitive process to award sub-grants
- Local levels of performance
- High performing boards
- Contracts for training services
- Public comment period for local plan
- Integrated technology for One-stop partners
- Governor requested information

Recap of State Plan Timeline

- State Plan out for public comment end of Nov for 30 days.
- State plan approved at January SWIC meeting, and then submitted to DOL/DOE by March 3rd.
- State plan approved by feds within 90 days of submission unless modifications required.

Tentative Local Plan Timeline

- Due by May 1st
 - 30 day public comment required at local level prior to submission to SWIC
- Each Region would present at either May or July SWIC meeting
- Local plan approved by Governor within 90 days of submission unless modifications required.
