mobility and independence; and

WHEREAS, for those with sight, the white cane serves as a reminder of their

responsibility to help protect the safety of individuals who are blind or visually impaired and of their importance of observing

the pedestrian's right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the white cane has become nationally recognized as an important

instrument to the independence and safety of persons who are

blind or visually impaired;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim October 15, 2024 as

WHITE CANE SAFETY DAY

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
