Indiana State Epidemiological Outcomes Workgroup (SEOW)

The Indiana State Epidemiological Outcomes Workgroup (SEOW) is a grant-supported collaborative of addiction, mental health, and behavioral health experts from state agencies and the public and private sectors whose mission is to:

- 1) Analyze substance use, mental health, and behavioral health data and identify public health trends.
- 2) Provide evidence-based recommendations for addressing problematic public health trends.
- 3) Deliver data-informed suggestions for establishing statewide prevention priorities.

Special Topics Reports

SEOW Special Topic Reports (STR) aims to identify and provide current information and policy recommendations for emerging issues related to substance use/misuse and mental and behavioral health in Indiana. STRs are intended to be utilized for strategic planning by addiction practitioners, researchers, community stakeholders and coalitions, state agencies, and local and state elected officials.

The objective of this STR is to:

- 1) Provide a basic overview and ecological assessment of statewide special populations, including colleges and universities.
- 2) Identify geographic service distribution gaps and program evaluation needs for special populations and services within the IASS (Indiana Addiction Services System).
- 3) Provide recommendations on how to address identified special populations and services deficits.
- 4) Provide recommendations on how to strategically enhance and expand special population and services efforts through the optimization of the IASS.

Assessing the geographic availability of special populations and services for Indiana communities is critically important with regard to evaluating the functionality of the IASS and identifying service gaps that can initiate or exacerbate problematic mental and/or behavioral health trends. Within the scope of the SEOW, examining the Special Populations and Services Domain specifically serves to distinguish the capacity of the IASS to stabilize homes and communities experiencing mental and behavioral health challenges, which in turn, addresses key risk and protective factors that are foundational components of substance misuse prevention theories and interventions. These factors include issues such as community disorganization and low community attachment, family conflict and management, parental attitudes towards substance misuse, and a belief in the moral order (Hawkins, Catalano, & Miller, 1992).

This STR also describes the Community Addiction Services Assessment (CASA) model which is the framework utilized by the SEOW to evaluate the IASS. The goal of the SEOW is to implement the CASA every three years to capture changes in the system and to make recommendations for addressing service system deficits, improving service system capacities, and for expanding the IASS workforce.

Introduction

In September of 2022, the Indiana Behavioral Health Commission released their final report on the current state of the Indiana Behavioral Health Care System and issued recommendations for improvement. As part of the report, the commission specifically suggested:

- 1) Utilizing the nationwide 988 crisis line as a mechanism for developing a statewide crisis response system.
- 2) Transitioning the Indiana system of Community Mental Health Centers to the federally supported Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) model.
- 3) Increasing public health services and interventions in criminal justice settings and establishing a Medicaid waiver to allow for federal reimbursement for services provided to incarcerated individuals.

The commission also made specific recommendations for improving the recruitment, retention, and quality of the behavioral health workforce such as reducing barriers to licensing and providing tuition reimbursement programs. The report additionally addressed a number of miscellaneous recommendations such as the need to further explore the availability of youth services

and discussed potential funding options for proposed systematic changes (Indiana Behavioral Health Commission, 2022). The full Behavioral Health Commission Report can be accessed at INBHC Report.

Community Addiction Services Assessment

To build on the Indiana Behavioral Health Commission Report and to identify specific geographic regions with high addiction service needs and low addiction service resources, the Indiana SEOW developed a Community Addiction Services Assessment (CASA) to supplement existing workforce and service system enhancement efforts. The CASA was created to serve as an ecological framework for state agencies, policy makers, and ground level practitioners to coordinate, evaluate, and enhance the accessibility and efficiency of the Indiana Addiction Services System (IASS). The IASS can be defined as the statewide network of addiction resources, services, and programs used to assess, prevent, treat, manage, and/or reduce substance misuse and the associated public health consequences. The CASA is grounded in the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration's Strategic Prevention Framework (SPF). The SPF is a data-driven methodology for addressing macro substance misuse problems that utilizes components of socio-ecological modeling to assess existing community resources, evaluate public policies, and to implement interventions to address service system deficits. The framework is based on seven steps for assessing and enhancing addiction service capacities which include:

- (1) Assessment
- (2) Capacity
- (3) Planning
- (4) Implementation
- (5) Evaluation
- (6) Cultural Competence
- (7) Sustainability

In adapting and applying the SPF to the IASS, the SEOW hopes to create an evaluation tool that is flexible, dynamic, rigorous, and compatible/ communicable with both high-level research and within local community discussions.

The 1st iteration of the CASA was designed to assess statewide addiction service systems related to the Institute of Medicine's Continuum of Care, the Strategic Prevention Framework, and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Overdose Prevention Strategy (USHDHHS, 2023; SAMHSA, 2019). To evaluate the IASS, nine Addiction Service Domains were selected for inclusion in the initial implementation of the CASA tool. The selected domains consist of:

- 1) Assessment Services
- 2) Prevention Services
- 3) Treatment Services
- 4) Harm Reduction Services
- 5) Recovery Services
- 6) Crisis Services
- 7) Training & Technical Assistance Services
- 8) Supply Reduction Initiatives
- 9) Special Populations and Services

Special Populations and Services Domain

The CASA Special Populations and Services Domain comprises eight service categories. The selected categories include:

- 1) Criminal Justice Services
- 2) Youth Services
- 3) Telehealth Services
- 4) Local Health Department Service Health First Indiana
- 5) Minority Population Services
- 6) LGBTQ+ Services
- 7) Disabled Population Services
- 8) College/University Services

This report will focus on College/University services; the services for the other populations will come in a future report. Data on some of the College/University Services were not available at this time. But this is a working draft and additional data will be included in the future.

Colleges and Universities

Introduction

This section of the Special Populations and Services report was designed to summarize and map available addiction, mental and behavioral health services in colleges and universities across Indiana. From our research, there are 63 colleges and universities in Indiana, and 50 of them offer mental health, behavioral health and substance abuse services for their students, faculty and staff.

Methodology

In order to compile the data on the 48 colleges and universities in Indiana, a content analysis on each of these colleges and universities was done. Meaning that there was an Internet search for resources that each college had pertaining to mental health and substance abuse. Definitions

Categories	Definition
Mental Health	Disease or condition that is mental health related, such as depression, schizophrenia, anxiety, bipolar disorder or ADHD.
Substance Abuse	Disease or condition related to a substance use addiction, such as for alcohol, opioids, tobacco, marijuana, cocaine, etc. These addiction services could be for prevention, treatment or recovery.
In-Person	Services provided in-person, primarily on-campus, but possibly in-person at an external location
Virtual	Services provided over the internet, such as telehealth, counseling sessions, etc.
Internal Referral	Referral from the college med center to an in-school provider or specialist
External Referral	Paramount in this is connecting students to services that offer them the best chance of success. Therefore, the college facilitates referrals to an appropriate program in the community when students need detoxification services, addiction treatment or medication-assisted opioid recovery. Similarly, the college facilitates referrals to therapists in the community for students who need more frequent or longer-term individual therapy services than the college can offer.

Greek Life Programming	Prevention programs offered by Sororities or Fraternities on campus
Universal Substance Misuse Screenings	Program to identify individuals who have or are at risk for developing alcohol- or drug-related problems
Drug & Alcohol-Free Social Events	Substance Free Alternative Events are social and recreational events for college students that specifically exclude the use of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs.
Stress Management Events	Classroom activities designed to teach students a variety of practical and fun stress reduction techniques . These activities may be used to address a stressful situation in the moment (such as: during a lockdown, before and/or after a morning full of testing, or following difficult transitions).

Orientation Prevention Programming	Mental health and addiction prevention programs conducted during stud orientation, which is the period prior to the start of the academic year at a colle or university where a variety of events are held to welcome and acclimate n students.		
Universal Prevention Programming -UPP (general)	Universal prevention programs are delivered to large groups without any prior screening for drug abuse risk status of the individual program recipients. The entire population of college students is assumed at-risk for substance abuse.		
UPP – Alcohol	An alcohol focused prevention program delivered to the entire population of college students without any prior screening for drug abuse risk status. Entire population is assumed at-risk.		
UPP- Other Elicit Drugs	An adult drugs focused prevention program delivered to the entire population of college students without any prior screening for drug abuse risk status. Entire population is assumed at-risk.		
UPP – Problem Drugs	A problem drugs focused prevention program delivered to the entire population of college students without any prior screening for drug abuse risk status. Entire population is assumed at-risk.

Safe Ride Program	Free universal ride program is offered by the university to students as a safety feature for student recreational activities		
No-Fault Reporting	A program whereby a student can report dangerous activity or potential activity by themselves or others and not be punished.		
NaloxBox	An overdose emergency treatment box containing Naloxone, CPR mask and other items to provide an opioid rescue kit. These boxes could be located throughout the college.		
Naloxone Distribution	Program to reduce opioid overdose deaths through the provision of free naloxone, the generic naloxone nasal spray or Narcan naloxone nasal spray.

Individual Counseling	On-campus or external mental health or addiction counseling services for individuals		
Group Counseling	On-campus or external mental health or addiction counseling services for groups or couples		
Drop-In Services	Services that are available to the students at certain scheduled times without an appointment.		
Psychiatric and Medication Management Services	Counseling services and assessments provided by psychiatrists or management of medications by psychiatrists or medical providers.		
Crisis Services	A mental health crisis is any situation in which a person's behavior puts them at risk of hurting themselves or others and/or prevents them from being able to care for themselves or function effectively in the community. This may include considering suicide, thoughts of hurting other people, recent victim of sexual assault or extremely disorganized or bizarre thinking or perceptions. The school would offer on-campus or external, in-person or by phone or internet counselors or providers specialized in immediate crisis care.		
Telehealth	Services provided over the internet or telephone

Support Groups or 12-Step Program	Programs offered by the college/university either on-campus or external that provide addiction support groups or a 12-Step Program for alcohol or other drug addiction.		
Drug and Alcohol-Free Dorms	A Substance-Free Environment is a designated dorm or living area/floor in the residence halls, in which residents and their guest(s) agree not to possess, use or distribute alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco or other smoking materials.		

Mental Health Support	Counseling and group support programs offered during recovery for mental health conditions.

Education Campaigns	On-campus campaigns that provide research-based alcohol and drug prevention and early intervention programs, education, training and workshops and resources for students via peer educators and professional staff.
Mental Health Screening/ Assessment	On-campus assessments that are integrated with other therapy services and ranges from brief screening questions to a full-fledged evaluation of a student's mental health.
Substance Abuse Screening/ Assessment	On-campus assessments that are integrated with other therapy services and ranges from brief screening questions to a full-fledged evaluation of a student's lifetime Alcohol or other drug use.
Campus Service Promotions	On or off-campus promotions or organizations that address substance misuse issues on campus or in the campus community that a student can join and participate in its mission and events.

Colleges/Universities Summary of Findings Among these 63 colleges:

- 79% or 50 colleges had Treatment services Clinical
- 49% or 31 colleges had Education and Assessment services
- 33% or 21 colleges had Prevention services
- 13% or 8 colleges had Recovery Supports
- 8% or 5 colleges had Harm Reduction services

The number of service types offered among the colleges were:

- 0 service types 13 or 21%
- 1 service types 14 or 22%
- 2 service types 16 or 25%
- 3 service types 15 or 24%
- 4 service types 1 or 2%
- 5 service types 4 or 6%

The best coverage of services is offered by:

- Ball State University 5 Types
- Butler University 5 Types
- Indiana Institute of Technology 5 Types
- Indiana University-Purdue University Indianapolis 5 Types

Of note, some of the key colleges/universities in the state do not offer all five types of services.

Indiana University-Bloomington offers 4 types, Purdue University offers 3 types and the University of Notre Dame offers 3 types.

Additionally, there are listed 19 lvy Tech campuses, and they tend to offer, as mentioned on their website, only one service - Treatment Services - Clinical, with a few offering Education and Assessment services. In total, there are 7 or 37% lvy Tech Campuses with Treatment Services and 3 or 16% of lvy Tech Campuses with Education and Assessment Services, and 12 or 63% Campuses with no services listed.

The highest coverage is for Treatment Services – Clinical with 79%, although it seems that all colleges should offer this service.

The lowest coverage is for Harm Reduction and Recovery Services and these may be increased with more NaloxBox and Nalox distribution, and the recovery services may be offered off campus at partner medical organizations.

The two services that should be evaluated for expansion are Prevention Services and Education and Assessment Services. Both of these types of services can have higher coverage with the addition of both of these services at Ivy Tech Campuses and the smaller, private colleges, such as DePauw, Huntington, Indiana Wesleyan, and Rose-Hulman. Of these two, the key focus should be on increasing and improving the availability, quantity and quality of prevention services at the colleges/universities
