

# **PathWays HCBS Waiver waiting list**

Process flow (not in PathWays program)

The steps below outline the process to apply to the Health and Wellness Waiver waiting list.

#### **Apply for PathWays HCBS Waiver**

Contact your local Area Agency on Aging office to complete a preliminary Level of Care screening by telephone. Your local Area Agency on Aging contact information is at <a href="www.in.gov/fssa/da/area-agencies-on-aging">www.in.gov/fssa/da/area-agencies-on-aging</a>.

Once you are found eligible for the preliminary level of care, the AAA will mail you an official letter about your waiting list placement.

The Area Agency on Aging will discuss Indiana Medicaid eligibility with you. If you appear to be eligible for Medicaid, the Area Agency on Aging will inform you and may assist you with this application. You may apply for Indiana PathWays for Aging at any time.

### On the PathWays HCBS Waiver waiting list

While you are on the PathWays HCBS Waiver waiting list:

Your local Area Agency on Aging may assist you with information and resources available in your community while you are waiting.

You may call Indiana 211 for additional information about resources in your community.

If you currently receive Indiana Medicaid, the Area Agency on Aging may support you in seeking home care services.

## Invitation to continue the process to access the PathWays HCBS Waiver

When your name comes up on the waiting list:

You will receive a letter of invitation in the mail from FSSA.

The Area Agency on Aging will assign an options counselor to contact you to schedule an in-person assessment. You may also reach out to your Area Agency on Aging to initiate the process.

Services begin once:

Indiana Medicaid is approved by the Division of Family Resources; and



The Waiver is approved by the Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning.
