What is CT?

CT are funds available for setup expenses for individuals transitioning from a nursing facility institute to a community-based setting. CT funds can be used for:

- Basic furnishing
 - o Bed, table, chairs, bedding, eating utensils, housekeeping supplies, microwave, bath linens, etc.
- Security deposits and application fees
- Safety assurances
 - o Pest eradication, allergen control, one time cleaning

Individuals have a *lifetime* cap of \$1500 for CT funds.

What is needed to provide CT?

Must be a CMGT provider to be able to provide CT services.

How to apply for CT?

Prepare the following documents:

Documents to Gather

- W-9 Tax Form/EIN
- Background Check (for owner and current employed)
- Liability Insurance Policy
- Secretary of State Letter
