What is PEST?

PEST services use insecticides to remove pests from an individual's home. Pests include roaches, mosquitoes, bed bugs, fleas, mites, ticks, rats, mice, etc.

PEST has an annual cap of \$4,000.

What is needed to provide PEST?

Pesticide applicators must be certified or licensed through the Purdue University Extension Service and the Office of the Indiana State Chemist.
