What is RBH?

RBH assist individual with daily ACTIVITIES due to physical and developmental disabilities. RBH can provide up to a full day of services/supports.

RBH will provide supervision, monitoring, and training for the following activities:

- Personal care, meals, shopping, errands, chore, and leisure activities
- Transportation
- Coordination and facilitation of medical and non-medical services

What is needed to provide RBH?

Habilitation services must be performed by persons who are supervised by:

- A certified brain injury specialist (CBIS)
- Qualified Mental Retardation Professional (QMRP)
- Qualified Intellectual Disability Professional (QIDP)
- Physical, occupational, or speech therapist licensed by the state of Indiana who has completed training or has experience in conducting habilitation programs

How to apply for RBH?

Prepare the following documents:
