- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

• Anaplasma species results from cell culture, IFA, PCR, ELISA, dot-ELISA, immunohistochemical methods or microscopic examination.

Condition Specific Reporting Details

• Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment Information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report.

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable medical records (if available).
- Outpatient office visits.
- Specialty consults.
- Emergency department/hospital discharge summary.
- Other pertinent patient details and outpatient provider's contact information (as applicable).
