#### **TO REPORT:**

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in NBS
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

## **Associated Reportable Laboratory Results**

- Babesia species by light microscopy Wright/Giemsa blood smear,
- PCR, Nucleic acid amplification.

### **Condition Specific Reporting Details**

• Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report.

#### **Additional Documentation to Include**

- Applicable medical records (if available) including outpatient office visits, specialty consults, emergency department/Hospital discharge summaries, and travel history.
- Documentation of recent blood/organ/tissue donation or receipt.
- Name and contact information of follow up provider should be listed in the Administrative Comments section of the morbidity report.
