• *Cryptosporidium* organisms, DNA, or antigen from a clinical specimen (all test types and specimen types)

### **Condition Specific Reporting Details**

 Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

#### **Additional Documentation to Include**

- · Applicable lab results
- Applicable patient medical records (if available)
- Any noted exposure history, including travel
