## Condition Name:

*Escherichia coli* (*E. coli*)  
infection (Shiga toxin-  
producing *E. coli* (STEC))

## Condition Name in NBS:

Shiga toxin-producing *Escherichia coli* (STEC)

## Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

## TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

## Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Isolation or detection of *Escherichia coli* (*E. coli*) O157 in a clinical specimen
- Detection of Shiga toxin or Shiga toxin genes in a clinical specimen
- Detection of non-O157 *E. coli* STEC/Enterohemorrhagic *E. coli* (EHEC) in a clinical specimen

## Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

## Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results
- Applicable patient medical records (if available)
- Any noted exposure history, including travel
