## Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- HIV confirmed positive diagnostic and serologic test results, which can include CD4 T-lymphocyte count and percentage and/or viral load count,
- should be both initial and supplemental reports.

## Condition Specific Reporting Details

- All persons of all ages (i.e., adults and adolescents aged  $\geq 13$  years and children aged  $< 13$  years) are to be reported within 1 working day.
- HIV positive pregnant woman or perinatally exposed infants are to be reported within 1 working day.
- Babies born to HIV-positive mothers must be reported to the Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) within 1 working day following birth.
