### **Condition Name:**

Hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS), post-diarrheal

## **Condition Name in NBS:**

Hemolytic uremic synd, postdiarrheal

## **Reporting Timeframe:**

**Immediately** 

## **TO REPORT:**

**Step 1:** Call **317-233-7125**

#### Step 2:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in NBS
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

## **Associated Reportable Laboratory Results**

- Any laboratory results pertaining to diarrheal pathogen testing
- Testing related to HUS such as microangiopathic hemolytic anemia, renal injury, Thrombocytopenia (TTP), platelet count, creatinine level, etc.

## **Condition Specific Reporting Details**

 Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

## **Additional Documentation to Include**

- Applicable lab results (including any E. coli lab results)
- Applicable patient medical records (if available)
- Clinical documentation of HUS or Thrombotic thrombocytopenic purpura (TTP)
- Any noted exposure history, including travel
