Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in <u>NBS</u>
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

• Detection of hantavirus-specific IgM or rising IgG titers by ELISA, hantavirusspecific RNA by PCR in clinical specimens, or immunohistochemistry in lung biopsy or autopsy specimens.

Condition Specific Reporting Details

• Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment Information sections within the NBS morbidity report.

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable medical records (if available) including outpatient office visits, specialty consults, and emergency department/hospital discharge summaries.
- Travel history and known rodent or lab exposures
