# **TO REPORT:**

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in <u>NBS</u>
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

#### **Associated Reportable Laboratory Results**

• Immunoglobulin M (IgM) antibody to hepatitis E virus (anti-HEV) and Immunoglobulin G (IgG) antibody to hepatitis E virus (anti-HEV) positive

### **Condition Specific Reporting Details**

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report
- Available information on patient symptoms

### **Additional Documentation to Include**

- Lab results (Hepatic Panel and/or Comprehensive Metabolic Panel)
- Applicable patient medical records (if available)
- Any noted exposure history, including travel
