TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in <u>NBS</u>
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Leptospira organisms from a clinical specimen
- Leptospira agglutination titer by MAT in serum specimen
- Detection of *Leptospira* DNA, IgM, or demonstration of *Leptospira* or *Leptospira* antibodies in a clinical specimen

Condition Specific Reporting Details

Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS
Morbidity Report

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results (culture, IgM, MAT, PCR, or other supporting labs)
- Applicable patient medical records (if available)
- Any noted exposure history, including animal and water exposures and travel
