- For NBS users: Please report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Positive Plasmodium species (*P. falciparum*, *P. malariae*, *P. ovale*, *P. vivax*) from RDT, PCR, or detection of malaria parasites in blood films (blood smear).

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS morbidity report

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable medical records (if available) including outpatient office visits, specialty consults, and emergency department/hospital discharge summaries.
- Travel history
- Plasmodium species and parasitemia
