## **Reporting Timeframe:**

Within One Working Day

# **TO REPORT:**

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in <u>NBS</u>
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

## **Associated Reportable Laboratory Results**

• Report to a major hospital emergency department for initial dose of human rabies immune globulin (HRIG) and rabies vaccine due to availability of product.

### **Condition Specific Reporting Details**

• Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report.

### **Additional Documentation to Include**

Additional doses of the vaccine may be administered in a smaller clinic

- Day 1—HRIG + rabies vaccine
- Day 3— Rabies vaccine
- Day 7— Rabies vaccine
- Day 14— Rabies vaccine
