## **Condition Name**:

**Tuberculosis (TB)** 

## **Condition Name in NBS:** Tuberculosis

**Reporting Timeframe:** Within One Working Day

## **TO REPORT:**

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in <u>NBS</u>
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

### **Associated Reportable Laboratory Results**

- Mycobacterium tuberculosis (including isolate submission)
- Positive Interferon-Gamma Release Assay (IGRA) result

### **Condition Specific Reporting Details**

 Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report may be skipped if Report of Tuberculosis is completed and attached

### **Additional Documentation to Include**

- Completed <u>Report of Tuberculosis (State Form 10458)</u>
- AFB results (Smear, NAAT, Culture)
- Radiography
- IGRA and/or TST
- Treatment information, including DOT records
