- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

## Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

• Positive IFA IgG antibody titers, detection of SFR DNA by PCR, IHC, cell culture, ELISA, dot-ELISA, or latex agglutination

#### **Condition Specific Reporting Details**

Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment Information sections within the NBS morbidity report

## **Additional Documentation to Include**

- Applicable medical records (if available) including outpatient office visits, specialty consults, and emergency department/hospital discharge summaries.
- Name and contact information of follow up provider should be listed in the Administrative Comments section of the morbidity report.
