### **Condition Name:**

*Streptococcus pneumoniae*, invasive disease

**Condition Name in NBS:** 

Strep pneumoniae, invasive

### **Reporting Timeframe:**

Within One Working Day

## **TO REPORT:**

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in <u>NBS</u>
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

#### **Associated Reportable Laboratory Results**

- Identification of *Streptococcus pneumoniae* by culture or PCR from a normally sterile body site.
- Report results of any antimicrobial susceptibility testing for invasive cases.
- For case-patients less than 5 years old, submit isolates for serotyping.

#### **Condition Specific Reporting Details**

• Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report.

#### **Additional Documentation to Include**

• Relevant clinical documentation, if available.
