Reminder Recall Quick Reference Guide

What is Reminder Recall?

The Reminder Recall module in CHIRP is a tool used to retrieve patients who are due to receive a vaccine or a vaccine series. Using Reminder Recall has been shown to improve vaccination coverage rates. It is also used to avoid wastage before a vaccine expires by identifying patients who need a dose.

How to run Reminder Recall:

The instructions below show how to generate a list of patients who are recommended to receive a Varicella immunization. The Reminder/Recall module is fully compatible with Internet Explorer.

1. Select Reminder/Recall module:

2. Under "Who do you want to Contact":

a. If the CHIRP user has access to more than one facility, confirm correct Organization & Facility are selected

b. Patient Age Range:

I. Can be a combination of days, months, or years

II. VFC ages = 1 day to 18 years of age

3. Under "Which vaccines would you like to include"

- a. "Select a series" is the default view.
- b. There are pre-set series from which to pick by clicking the down arrow.
 - I. Examples include the DTaP series and Adolescent Assessments
 - II. For specific vaccines such as varicella, select "Custom" series
 - 1. For purposes of this example, select Varicella.

2. Since we are trying to capture anyone who needs a dose of the varicella vaccine, we will not enter a dose number.

Check the box to select vaccine(s): Enter a dose number (optional):
DTaP/DT/Td HIB POLIO HEP-B 3 DOSE MMR

4. After selecting a series or specific vaccine, click on the "Patient List" button at the bottom right.



- 5. Narrow search results to eliminate patients who may be difficult to contact.
 - a. Patients who do not have a name listed in the CHIRP registry.

b. If the plan is to contact patients by phone, eliminate patients who do not have a phone number in CHIRP.

c. In the example below, the two patients who do not have a phone number in CHIRP are **inactivated**.

d. Note that patients can be deactivated in this screen. Please refer to **ISDH Policy 21 for deactivation** guidelines.





6. The search results can be retrieved in two ways:

a. Export Patient List

I. This generates a CSV document that can be opened in Excel

II. All missing vaccines for each patients will be retrieved by using this method.

b. Submit

I. Brings up a new screen

II. Green icons at the top indicate the total # of patients, patients with mailing addresses, phone numbers, mobile numbers, and email addresses in CHIRP.

III. Blue icons in the box show output options.

7. A prompt to confirm selection will appear.

a. This window allows you to tell CHIRP whether or not you want to track the number of times a patient is contacted for vaccinations.

b. Click "Run" to continue



8. For "Generate a Patient List", a document will be generated in a separate window. This list can be printed or saved as a PDF file.
