Indiana Virtual Naloxone Training Guide

Purpose

The Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) is pleased to offer virtual naloxone administration trainings that are free and self-paced. These courses cover topics such as Indiana overdose statistics, stigma reduction, naloxone administration, and treatment options for substance use disorder.

IDOH is offering three online courses available on the Indiana TRAIN Platform:

- Naloxone Administration Training: First Responders: ID 1122357
- Naloxone Administration Training: First Responder Refresher: ID 1122441
- Naloxone Administration Training: Public: ID 1122355

Please note: the First Responder Refresher course is reserved for first responders who have already completed a complete naloxone administration training.

- Signing On
 - Visit the Indiana TRAIN homepage: <u>https://www.train.org/indiana/</u>
 - If you already have a TRAIN account, log in with your username and password.
 Otherwise, click the "Create account" button.
- Creating an Account
 - Follow the prompts to enter the requested information and create your account.
 - Follow the instructions to verify your account email.
- Complete Profile
 - Before you can access the training, you must complete your profile. On the Indiana TRAIN home page, click on your name in the top right corner, and select "Your Profile."
